

Band plans Canada trip this summer

The music department of McFarland high school is continuing plans for a trip which the high school band hopes to make this summer. A spaghetti supper was held Tuesday, April 7, at the high school.

The trip is planned for June 25-28 with the destination Winnipeg, Canada, where the band will perform in international band

competition. High school bands from virtually every country in the world may compete for honors.

During the past months, the band members have been working on various fund-raising campaigns, including a candy sale, car washes and bottle drives, in order to raise the needed money.

According to Thomas Dvorak, director of the high school band, the entire trip will cost the band approximately \$4,000. To this date the band has raised nearly \$2,000 (prior to the spaghetti supper). Dvorak also stated that, "the money for the trip must be raised by May 29th." If the needed funds aren't raised by that time the trip would be postponed

until the following year.

According to Dvorak, "The honor of attending an event of this magnitude is certainly another outstanding achievement for the high school band. The presence of our band at Winnipeg should bring a great deal of pride to our school, community, and state. Let's give our band all the support they need!"
