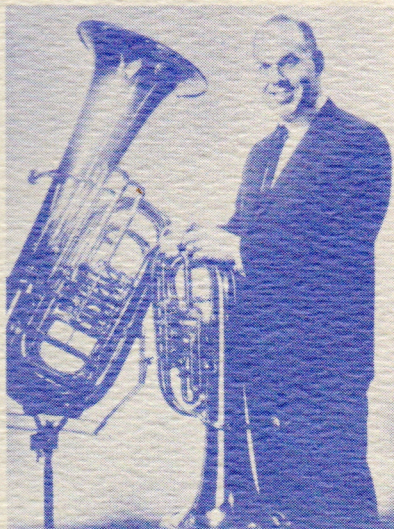

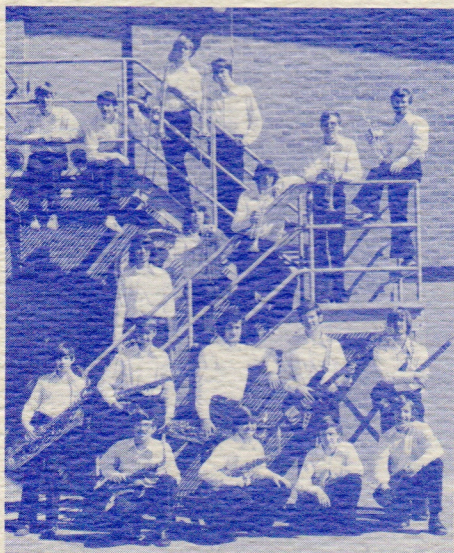

RICH MATTESON

Rich Matteson has had a wide and varied career as performer, arranger, clinician and teacher. A graduate of the University of Iowa, he has been a school band director and has performed from coast to coast and written for many name groups. He is presently featured soloist on valve trombone, bass trumpet and euphonium with the Joe Morello group. Mr. Matteson has established himself as one of the most exciting jazz soloists, and is a dedicated clinician. The fact that student low brass players now have someone to identify with, has been most helpful to those band directors who have engaged his services.

The McFarland High School Jazz Ensemble was formed four years ago by Thomas Dvorak. During this time the group has become one of the most popular musical groups in the school and community.

Last year (1972) the jazz ensemble was selected as the most outstanding high school jazz ensemble at the annual UW-Platteville Jazz Festival. This year, the band repeated that selection and for the second time won the UW-Platteville Jazz Festival.
