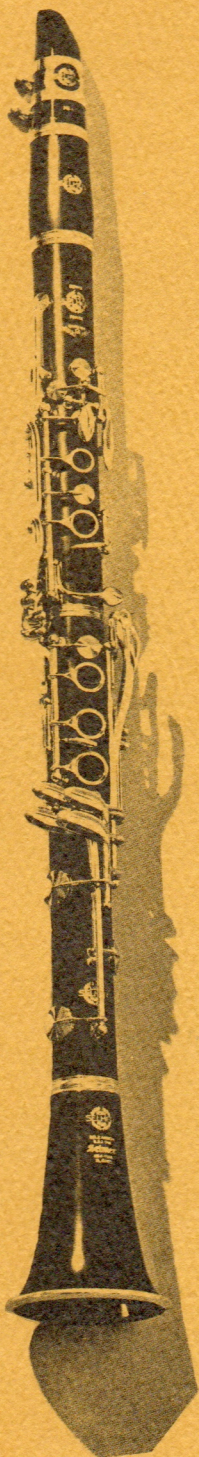

In performing as a guest soloist with the McFarland High School Band, Dr. William B. Tietze brings to the task a colorful and very distinguished career in all phases of music and music education. Presently Director of Bands and Director of Graduate Music at Wisconsin State University, Platteville, Wisconsin, Mr. Tietze also serves as a band festival clinician, woodwind clinician, and performer throughout the Midwest. Before coming to Platteville he had over 27 years of serving either as clarinetist, director, or advisor with such outstanding groups as the United States Navy Band, Jacksonville Symphony Orchestra, Wisconsin Arts Foundation and Council, and the Music Educators National Conference.

In addition to being active in many professional music organizations, he has written articles for the **Clarinet, Woodwind World,** and **Instrumentalist** and was elected to Who's Who in American Education in 1961. It is with great pride and pleasure that we present Dr. William B. Tietze as soloist and clinician.
