After receiving the Bachelor and Master of Music degrees from the University of Michigan and following a series of successes in elementary and high school music education in Michigan and California, Mr. Reynolds went on to develop one of the largest and finest college bands at California State College at Long Beach. In addition to his skill as an educator, he has earned the praise of such noted composers as Aaron Copland and Darius Milhaud for his interpretive conducting of their works. He is active in many professional organizations including the: American Bandmasters Association, College Band Directors National Association, Music Educators National Conference, and Wisconsin Music Educators Conference. Prior to his leaving Southern California he received the "Gold Award of Recognition" from the Southern California School Band and Orchestra Association. He also remains active as a French Horn Player and while on the West Coast was a member of the Los Angeles French Horn Club. He is in constant demand as a clinician and guest conductor throughout the nation.
